



NPR Music returns to Austin to bring audiences everywhere a taste of South by Southwest and talk to the musicians behind the city's sounds. For the third straight year, NPR Music opens SXSW with a headlining showcase at Stubb's, and presents a daytime concert the following afternoon—featuring two of the most dynamic lineups of the festival. The performances are accessible through free live webcasts at www.npr.org/sxsw and live streaming via the NPR iPhone App, as well as broadcasts on NPR Member stations across the country. Hosting both shows are NPR Music's Bob Boilen and Carrie Brownstein, and KUT's David Brown.

Joining NPR Music in festival coverage are five station partners – KUT Austin, WFUV New York, WXPB Philadelphia, KEXP Seattle and The Current from Minnesota Public Radio.
