

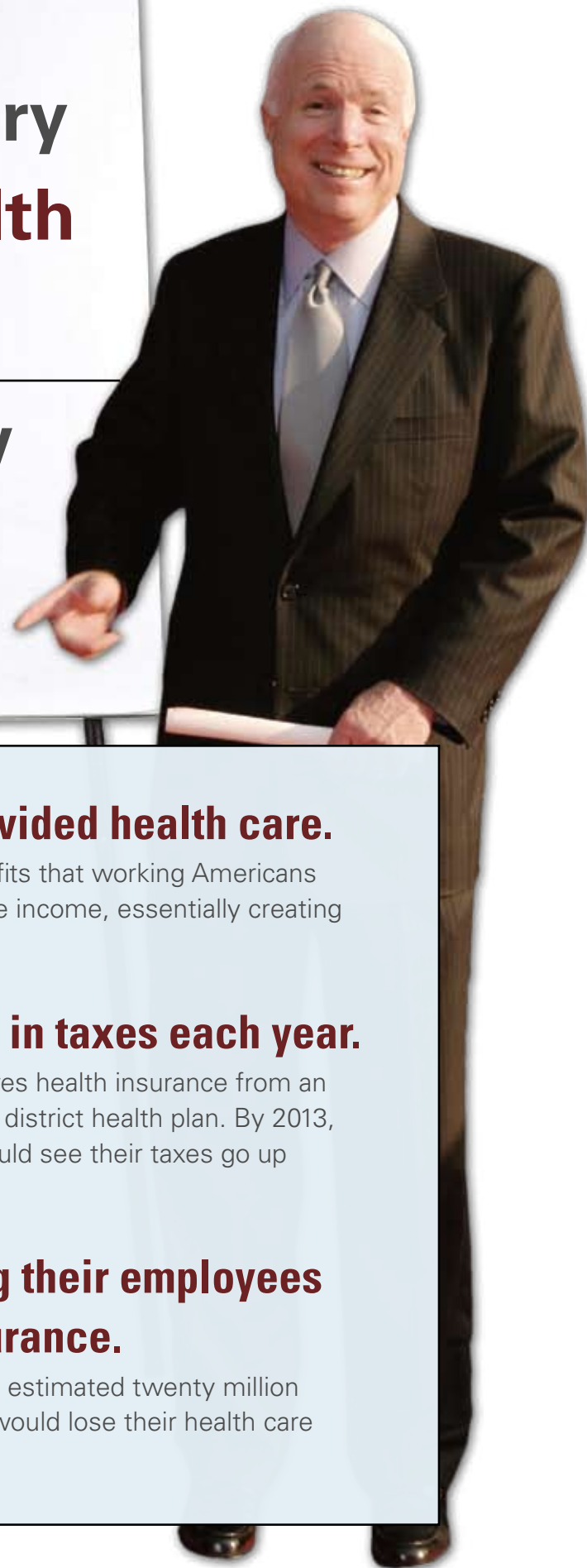

A new tax on employer-provided health care.

McCain's plan would make the health care benefits that working Americans receive from their employers part of their taxable income, essentially creating a new tax on working families.⁵

McCain's plan would affect everyone who receives health insurance from an employer, including families covered by a school district health plan. By 2013, an average American couple making \$60,000 could see their taxes go up approximately \$1,100.⁶

Experts predict the new tax would mean that an estimated twenty million Americans currently covered by their employer would lose their health care coverage altogether.⁷
